

What is a Credit Union? A federal credit union is a cooperative, not-for-profit financial institution organized to promote thrift and provide credit to its members (who are also its customers). Federal credit union members are provided with a safe, convenient place to save and borrow at reasonable rates, with savings insured up to \$250,000 by the National Credit Union Share Insurance Fund (NCUSIF).
